### Berth in ILCS on the Line

The top two teams in the Ivy League earn the right to advance to the best-of-three championship series next weekend. While Dartmouth is currently in second place, it has some work to do in the final series of the season at Harvard to hold on to its position. First, the Big Green have to beat the Crimson just once to eliminate them from the race. Additionally, Dartmouth must end the weekend by beating Harvard at least as many times as Columbia wins at Cornell in their three-game series. The cherry on top of all of this would be if the Green swept Harvard and Penn swept first-place Yale; Dartmouth would then host the Ivy League Championship Series on May 19-20.

### The Overall Record vs. Harvard

- By the end of this series, Dartmouth will have played the Crimson more than any other opponent. The Big Green have taken 26 of the last 30, but Harvard still holds a 132-126 lead.
- Last year the two teams split the four games with each winning once at the two venues, ending a streak of six straight years in which Dartmouth won the series while boasting a 22-2 mark, including 15 wins in a row at one point.
- The Big Green have not lost the season series against Harvard since 2005, winning eight and splitting five.
- Harvard has been playing at the site of O'Donnell Field since 1898, beating Dartmouth in the inaugural game, 13-7. Since 1923, the Big Green are 47-54 (.465) at the site.

### Scouting the Crimson

- Harvard, playing for the first time in two weeks due to final exams, is one of just two teams in the Ivy League with a winning record overall this season (20-19) and has the second-best RPI (156) behind only Yale (144).
- The Crimson are averaging 5.8 runs a game while hitting .262/.361/.369 as a team overall, but have been a little better against the Ivy League at 6.2 runs per game and a line of .278/.377/.385.
- Center fielder Ben Skinner leads Harvard with a .329 average and 15 stolen bases, while Patrick Robinson is close behind in average at .325.
- Five players have at least three home runs, led by

Jake Suddleson with five and Robinson with four.

- On the mound, the staff has a 5.74 ERA for the season, sixth in the league, but that figure drops to 4.15 in conference play, only slightly higher than Dartmouth's 4.06.
- The Crimson rely heavily upon their top two starters, RHP Noah Zavolas and RHP Simon Rosenblum-Larson, both of whom have struck out 72 batters in 64 and 57 innings, respectively.
- The bullpen has been anchored by RHP Hunter Bigge (2-2, 2.81, 3 saves) while RHP Kieran Shaw leads the team with four saves.
- The defense ranks last in fielding percentage in league play at .954 and has contributed to more than one unearned run scoring per game. But the catches have done a good job limiting the running game, throwing out 6-of-19 potential base stealers.

### Last Time Against Harvard

All four games were tight contests with Dartmouth winning the first game of each doubleheader, 2-1 at home and 3-0 on the road, while the Crimson took the nightcaps, 7-6 and 8-7. Solo homers by **Kyle Holbrook** and **Michael Calamari** in the first game gave the Green a 2-0 lead entering the seventh and final frame, but Harvard loaded the bases with nobody out. But Chris Burkholder got a strikeout, a sacrifice fly and a strikeout to earn his eighth save.

It looked as if Dartmouth would sweep the first twinbill as it took a 6-1 lead into the eighth inning. But the Crimson rallied for six in the eighth, the last two scoring on a dropped fly ball. The Big Green threatened to reclaim the lead after drawing two walks to start the eighth, but the next six batters went down in order to give Harvard the win.

In Cambridge, Beau Sulser made the most of his final collegiate start, twirling a two-hit shutout with eight strikeouts. **Nate Ostmo** tripled home two runs in the second and scored shortly thereafter to provide all of the offense in the 3-0 victory.

The final game was a back-and-forth affair. Dartmouth led, 5-3, until Harvard scored three in the seventh. But **Trevor Johnson's** two-out, two-run homer in the ninth put the Big Green back on top, 7-6. The lead would not last, unfortunately, beginning with a leadoff walk, and Harvard answered with two runs of its own on a single and an error to walk off with the 8-7 triumph.

## HEAD COACH BOB WHALEN



A mainstay in Hanover, Bob Whalen is in his 29th season as Dartmouth's head baseball coach. Whalen has guided the Big Green to success both on and off the field since his arrival prior to the 1990 season.

Under his leadership, the Big Green have accumulated two Ivy League

crowns, 11 Red Rolfe Division titles, 74 first-team All-Ivy and All-EIBL League selections, and sent 28 players to the professional ranks.

Prior to his arrival at Dartmouth, Whalen was an assistant at the University of Maine from 1982-89 and was promoted to associate head coach in 1987. From 1982-87, he worked mainly with infielders and outfielders while serving as the strength and conditioning coach and the recruiting coordinator.

In addition to his collegiate coaching career, Whalen served as the head coach of the Chatham A's of the Cape Cod League in 1988 and 1989. He coached former Houston Astros first baseman Jeff Bagwell, the 1994 National League MVP, and 25 others who signed professionally.

Whalen earned a bachelor's degree in 1979 and his MBA in finance in 1986. Whalen and his wife, Kim, have a son, Matt, and a daughter, Katie.

## at Harvard — May 13-14, 2018

### Probable Starting Pitchers

- Dartmouth will continue with its weekend rotation as it has all year with junior RHP **Cole O'Connor** (5-4, 4.15) getting the nod for game one. He threw six shutout innings against Princeton — extending his streak to 13 — before tiring in the seventh in a 14-3 rout.
- Harvard will send ace RHP Noah Zavalas (6-1, 2.81) to the mound to square off against O'Connor. The senior has a no-hitter to his credit this season, a 12-strikeout gem against Yale.
- For game two, the Big Green have senior RHP **Jack Fossand** (4-3, 4.10) lined up. In league action, he is 3-1 with a 2.70 ERA with quality starts in five of his six appearances, including 7.2 scoreless stanzas last week against Princeton.
- The Crimson will hand the ball to ace number two, RHP Simon Rosenblum-Larson (3-2, 2.84), in the nightcap of the doubleheader. Opponents are hitting just .219 against him, second-lowest in the league, and he leads the loop with 11.4 strikeouts per nine innings.
- Senior RHP **Clay Chatham** (2-4, 5.03) will take his turn in the final game, coming off a six-inning start in which he allowed one unearned run on three hits versus the Tigers. His last two starts (both Big Green victories) have yielded just one earned run in 11 innings with 13 strikeouts.
- For Harvard, the final starter will likely hinge on what happens in the first two games. Betting either RHP Hunter Bigge (2-2, 2.81) or RHP Kevin Stone (3-4, 7.46) will be on the mound.

### What's Up Next

Hopefully a trip to the Ivy League Championship Series on May 19-20. How Dartmouth would qualify for the event for the ninth time in the past 11 seasons, but first since 2015, is outlined in the very first note, so why don't you go back and read that if you don't remember?

### Last Week in Review

- Dartmouth played one last non-conference game on Wednesday and cruised to a 12-1 win over Division III Middlebury. **Michael Calamari** hit a three-run homer, while **Blake Crossing** and **Bennett McCaskill** both singled, doubled and drove in two runs in the blowout.
- The Big Green bats first awoke over the weekend, pounding Princeton by a combined score of 36-6 in a three-game sweep of the Tigers, the first

sweep for Dartmouth in the new league format.

- Co-captain **Dustin Shirley** drove in five runs in the opener to lead the Green to a 14-3 victory while **Cole O'Connor** picked up the win and **Mike Concato** tossed 2.2 shutout innings of relief to finish it out.
- Jack Fossand** would have been the story in game two with 7.2 shutout innings, but Dartmouth scored a season-high 16 runs as **Kyle Holbrook** had six RBIs and Calamari had four in a 16-1 rout.
- The final game was a bit more normal with the Big Green coming away 6-2 winners. **Clay Chatham** got the win on the mound while **Nate Ostmo** and **Steffen Torgersen** led the offense with a combined five hits, three runs and three RBIs.

### Shirley Academic All-District

Senior **Dustin Shirley** was named to the Google Cloud Academic All-District I Team as selected by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) this past week. The psychology major has a 3.75 GPA while hitting .290 with 13 doubles (tied for the Ivy lead), four homers and a team-high 28 RBIs. He is the first Big Green player selected to the team since 2014 when Jeff Keller earned the distinction shortly before being chosen an Academic All-America First Team member for the second straight year.

### Five in a Row

In April, Dartmouth posted a record of 6-8-1, its first losing record in that month since the 2007 campaign. But May has been much kinder as the Big Green have won all five of their games since May Day rolled around, including the 12-1 win over Middlebury on Wednesday. It is the longest winning streak since a 14-gamer late in the 2015 season propelled Dartmouth to its eighth-straight Ivy League Championship Series. By the way, over the previous 10 seasons (2008-17), the Big Green were 152-66-1 in April, a winning percentage of .696.

### From Runs, Runs, Runs ...

Before playing Princeton, Dartmouth had scored 29 runs in its previous nine contests. The Big Green surpassed that total in the doubleheader, winning by scores of 14-3 and 16-1. Tack on the 6-2 victory in the finale and Dartmouth amassed 36 runs in the three games, its most in an Ivy League weekend since scoring 38 against Harvard in 2012 (which was a four-game series). And with 12 more

runs against Middlebury, the Green had their most runs in any four-game stretch (48) since 2011 when they tallied 54 in late March of that year. By the way, the 16 runs against Princeton were the most for Dartmouth against a D-I opponent in three years.

### ... To Run Prevention

Apparently Dartmouth has been hogging all of the runs of late, because the pitching staff and defense have really stymied opposing offenses. Over the last nine games, the team ERA is a miniscule 1.93 with the pitchers issuing just eight walks in 84 innings. Five times the other team has scored just one run in this stretch — every other game as a matter of fact — as the Big Green have won seven of the nine games.

### Fagler Gets First Win

Sophomore **Tyler Fagler** has gotten the starting nod in every non-conference game since Ivy play started at the end of March, but he finally got his first collegiate win in a scheduled short start against Middlebury on May 9. The right-hander kept the Panthers off the scoreboard for three innings on two hits as Dartmouth jumped out to a 7-0 lead. Fagler is now 1-1 with a 4.22 ERA in four starts and seven relief appearances spanning 21.1 career innings.

### Calamari Takes Team Lead in HR

With his three-run blast against Middlebury on May 9, sophomore **Michael Calamari** is now the team leader with five home runs on the season. As a team, Dartmouth has clubbed 24 round-trippers, which ranks second to only this weekend's opponent, Harvard, who has 25 (but in two more games).

### Welcome Back Fowler

A hamstring injury sidelined senior third baseman **Justin Fowler** for 13 games spanning four weeks, but he finally got back in the lineup in the second game against Princeton. But it wasn't until the Middlebury game that he rapped out his first hits since returning, going 2-for-4 with a double, walk and an RBI in the 12-1 win. During his absence, junior **Steffen Torgersen** handled the hot corner quite well, fielding 34 chances without an error, plus hit .289 with three doubles in those 13 contests.

### Ivy Player, Pitcher of the Week

Junior shortstop **Nate Ostmo** and sophomore reliever **Austen Michel** were chosen as the Ivy League Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, after helping Dartmouth win all four games last week. Ostmo hit .353 with two homers, one of which was the only Big Green run until a walk-off hit in the 13th to beat Brown last Tuesday, 2-1. Michel was instrumental in that victory as well, hurling seven scoreless innings while allowing just one hit and retiring the final 17 batters of the game to earn the victory. He also finished the final win with two innings in a 6-2 triumph over Princeton, completing a three-game sweep of the Tigers.

## at Harvard — May 13-14, 2018

### RBI Deluge

Before the series against Princeton on May 5-6, there wasn't a single active player on the Dartmouth roster that had driven in more than three runs in any game for the Big Green. That all changed in the doubleheader on Saturday as senior **Dustin Shirley** had five RBIs on a two-run homer and a three-run double in the 14-3 win. But he wasn't the only one to gorge on RBIs that day as sophomore **Michael Calamari** drove in four of the first six runs in the nightcap with a two-run double and a two-run blast, and senior **Kyle Holbrook** trumped them all with six RBIs, all in his final three at-bats. The first two came on run-scoring singles, while the last four came on a grand slam to cap the 16-1 rout. It was the first grand slam by a Big Green hitter in four years (Jeff Keller vs. Harvard, April 29, 2014).

### Speaking of Bases Loaded

**Kyle Holbrook's** grand slam against Princeton is part of a larger trend among Big Green hitters over the past four games — producing with the bases loaded. Over the first 33 games, Dartmouth as a team was a woeful .105 (4-for-38) with all four hits being singles and 24 RBIs when every base was occupied. But in just the past four games, the Green have gone 9-for-16 with two doubles, Holbrook's home run and 22 RBIs to raise the season average in such situations to .241.

### Stellar Pitching

The bats got most of the attention against the Tigers, but the arms got it done as well. Junior **Cole O'Connor** began the weekend with six shutout stanzas before tiring in the seventh, picking up his fifth win of the year, and senior **Jack Fossand** followed with 7.2 scoreless innings of work on four hits and eight strikeouts in the nightcap to collect his fourth victory. It was senior **Clay Chatham's** turn on Sunday, yielding just one unearned run on three hits with six strikeouts in six innings on the mound for his second win of the season.

### Longest Game in 15 Years

It took Dartmouth 13 innings to knock off Brown on May Day, matching the longest game by innings during head coach Bob Whalen's 29-year tenure. The only other 13-inning game for Whalen came on March 20, 2008 in a 10-8 win at Pacific. There are only six games in Big Green history — spanning 3,872 contests — that have taken longer to finish:

Senior **Dustin Shirley** became the second of three Big Green players to be named the Ivy League Player of the Week this year for his performance in the doubleheader against Brown on April 28. ## Bulldogs Bite Big Green Again

Yale has become a bit of a nemesis for Dartmouth ever since the Big Green swept a four-game series in New Haven three years ago. Since then, the Bulldogs have not only won three consecutive series against Dartmouth (the only team to do so in the last 15 years), but also the 2016 Rolfe Division playoff game to advance to the Ivy League Championship Series.

## McCaskill McRookie of the Week

Easy McDonald's reference, but hey, why not? Freshman **Bennett McCaskill** was named the Ivy League Rookie of the Week for his performance in the series victory over Columbia the weekend of April 7-8. The son of former MLB pitcher Kirk McCaskill was 3-for-8 in the three games, including his first collegiate home run, which sparked a seven-run inning in the second game to help the Big Green clinch the series with a 10-4 win. In the 5-4 opening victory, the catcher went 2-for-3 with a run and a sacrifice bunt. So how did he celebrate the honor? Why, by belting a solo homer in his first at-bat against UMass Lowell, just minutes after the award was announced.

## Sleigh Bells or Baseballs?

Twice during Dartmouth's 12-8 loss to UMass Lowell at Red Rolfe Field at Biondi Park on April 10, the game was delayed for 13 minutes due to snow. Shortly before each delay, junior **Steffen Torgersen** drew a walk, his only bases on balls of the season. There may or may not be a correlation, but to be on the safe side, maybe everyone should just tell Torgersen to swing away. But the third baseman did score three runs in the game, tying the most by any Big Green player this season, so it wasn't all bad.

## Lion Tamer

Sophomore **Michael Parsons** should take his show on the road as well as he tames Lions. The southpaw shut down the Columbia offense, holding it scoreless for 5.2 innings on Sunday, to earn his first collegiate victory in the 10-4 win. It wasn't his first act in the center ring having picked up his only collegiate save last year at Columbia by hurling four shutout stanzas, giving him an ERA of 0.00 in 9.2 career innings against the Ivy League rival.

## Seven-Run Stanza

Trailing 4-0 in the second game of the series against Columbia, the Dartmouth bats exploded for seven runs in the third inning. The scoring was bookended by freshman **Bennett McCaskill's** first career home run and sophomore **Michael Calamari's** two-run blast. One month later, the Big Green put up seven runs in the sixth inning of a 14-3 win over Princeton. Dartmouth has not scored more runs in any inning since putting up eight runs in the eighth inning against Chicago on March 21 last year to beat the Maroons, 19-11. The last time they had seven against a Division I team was a seven-run eighth in a 22-10 win at Yale on April 11, 2015.

## Long Ball Long Time Coming

Junior **Matt Feinstein** got the home run monkey off his back over the weekend, clouting his first collegiate four-bagger against Columbia on Saturday, and it couldn't have come at a much better time. The center fielder cranked a three-run shot to cap a four-run second, which turned out to be the final Big Green runs in the 5-4 victory. The home run came in his 364th career plate appearance. And to top off his week, he added his 100th career hit with an RBI

### First League Tie in 31 Years

You can forgive some folks for wondering if Dartmouth and Penn were playing an April Fool's prank on them when the final game of the series, played on April 1, ended as a 4-4 tie after 11 innings due to darkness. It was the first tie in league play since Yale and Princeton battled to a draw in 1987, 31 years ago. And it was the first tie in a conference game for Dartmouth in 36 years when the Big Green and Navy battled to a 7-7 draw. The most recent tie of any kind came last year at Siena, 9-9.

### Fossand Fans 11

Right-hander **Jack Fossand** had his best stuff going at Penn on April 1 as he retired 16 of the first 17 batters he faced and made it through a career-high eight innings having surrendered one run while striking out a 11, also a personal best and the most by a Big Green pitcher in two years. His performance went for naught, however, as Penn rallied for three runs in the ninth in a game that ended in a 4-4 tie.

### Extra-Inning Blast

When senior **Kyle Holbrook** belted a two-out, solo home run in the 10th inning to give Dartmouth a 7-6 lead in the second game at Penn, it was the first four-bagger hit by a Big Green hitter in extra innings in 15 years. The last one was a walk-off, two-run shot off the bat of Kyle Zurhellen in the 11th inning for a 7-5 victory at Cornell on April 12, 2003. And yes, it was at Cornell and still a walk-off homer; the series was scheduled to be played in Hanover but weather forced it to be moved to Ithaca. The last Dartmouth long ball in extras hit in Hanover came the year prior by Derek Draper, a walk-off, solo shot to beat Yale, 7-6, in 10 innings.

### Got To Keep On Walking

Dartmouth certainly had enough base runners in the second game at Penn, thanks in part to Big Green batters drawing a dozen walks, their most since the 2017 season opener. On top of that, Quaker pitchers also hit three batters, giving Dartmouth 15 free base runners. Coincidentally, that is also the number of runners the Green left on base, their most since ... the 2017 season opener.

### Cole Fuels 5-4 Win at Penn

Junior **Cole O'Connor** provided a solid pitching performance in the Ivy League opener to help Dartmouth earn a 5-4 win at Penn on March 31. The right-hander faced one over the minimum through five innings and finished his stint with a quality start, yielding three runs over seven stanzas without a walk while striking out six. All told for the weekend, Big Green starters held the Quakers to one run combined over the first five innings in all of the three games.

### Home-Opening Win

The 11-4 triumph over Quinnipiac on March 28 was the Big Green's first home-opening win since 2013. Dartmouth is now 6-4 in home openers at Biondi Park, 19-10 under head coach Bob Whalen and 28-21 at Red Rolfe Field since it was dedicated in 1970. Little more than a week later, the Green won their 100th game at Biondi Park with a 5-4 victory over Columbia on April 7.

### Crossing Walks ... and Walks

Sophomore **Blake Crossing** had a rather leisurely, perfect day in the 11-4 win over Quinnipiac, going 1-for-1 with four walks. He is the first Big Green hitter to be issued four free passes in a game since Joe Sclafani '12 (Dartmouth's all-time leader in walks with 100) did so against Brown on April 15, 2012.

### Fowler Long-Ball Firsts

Senior **Justin Fowler** has made a habit of being the first Big Green hitter to belt a home run in certain situations this year. He was the first to hit a home run in 2018, that coming in the second game at Georgia Tech. He was the first to hit a four-bagger at home, which he did in the very first inning against Quinnipiac. He was the first to homer against a right-hander (at Georgia Tech) and a left-hander (Quinnipiac). And he was also the first to go yard in the first inning (Quinnipiac). Pretty impressive for a guy with just two homers ...

### Ivy League Pitcher of the Week

Prior to his start on March 4, senior **Clay Chatham** had started 12 games in his career but never thrown more than five innings nor won a game. That all changed against Georgetown as Chatham pitched eight complete innings and allowed just one run on seven hits without a walk to go with a career-high six strikeouts to earn his first victory, 4-1. His outing deservedly earned the Type 1 diabetic honor of Ivy League Pitcher of the Week, giving Dartmouth six of the 12 winners of the award since the start of last season.

### CSM Ivy Player of the Week

While the Ivy League office didn't give **Michael Calamari** the Player of the Week honor on March 5, College Sports Madness did. All the sophomore did was hit .462 over the three games at the Snowbird Classic in Florida with a home run, five runs scored and three RBIs, including career highs in hits (3) and RBIs (3) in the 12-7 win over Villanova. With performances like that, "Squid" will earn a lot of ink.

### Loss in Last Inning

When Northeastern rallied from an 8-5 deficit in the ninth to defeat Dartmouth on March 3 by a final of 10-8, it ended a streak of 83 consecutive games the Big Green had won when entering the ninth with a lead, dating back to the 2012 season. UC Irvine scored two in the bottom of the ninth on March 22, 2012, to walk off with a 5-4 victory. Of course, that doesn't count games in which Dartmouth took a lead during the ninth on the road then couldn't hold it (happened twice last year), or seven-inning games ...

# DARTMOUTH BASEBALL

## at Harvard — May 13-14, 2018

### Hit Barrage

Dartmouth may have lost a heartbreaker to Northeastern on March 3, 10-8, but the Big Green broke out the bats with 18 hits, their most hits against a Division I opponent since a 13-1 win over St. Bonaventure just over a year ago (Feb. 26, 2017).

### O'Connor Fans 10

Junior **Cole O'Connor** entered his start on March 3 with a career strikeout rate of 5.2 per nine innings with a career high of six. That changed against Villanova as the right-hander whiffed 10 Wildcats, becoming the first Big Green pitcher in *exactly* one year to hit double digits (Beau Sulser had 10 at No. 17 Miami last year). But he was only halfway to the school record of 20, set by Pete Broberg '72 against Boston College on May 14, 1971.

### Welcome Back Concato

Senior **Mike Concato** missed both the 2016 and 2017 seasons with an injury after earning All-Ivy Second Team honors as a sophomore in 2015. The right-hander finally returned to the mound for the Big Green, pitching out of the bullpen in the season opener, his first appearance in 1,021 days. Only one other player at the Division I level has suffered through a longer time between games before playing again this season, that being Clay Conaway, a pitcher for Delaware (1,041 days).

### Opening Day Defeat

Dartmouth was shut out at Georgia Tech on opening day, 10-0, its first blanking in the first game in four years and 11th ever in 146 seasons. Overall, the Big Green sport a record of 67-78-1 in their season opener and are 13-16 under head coach Bob Whalen.

### Back in Georgia 31 Years Later

With the series at Georgia Tech, Dartmouth made its first return to the state of Georgia for a baseball game since it played in the 1987 NCAA Northeast Regional at Chandler Stadium. The starting pitcher in a loss to Fordham (and the first baseman in the other two games) was none other than Mark Johnson, who enjoyed a seven-year MLB career and whose son, **Trevor Johnson**, started all three games for the Big Green, the first two in center field, the other as the DH.

### Two Taken in MLB Draft

Ivy League Pitcher of the Year Beau Sulser and All-Ivy second team pitcher Michael Danielak were both chosen in the MLB Draft as fifth-year seniors at Dartmouth. Sulser was taken in the 10th round by the Pittsburgh Pirates, while Danielak was selected in the 19th round by the Oakland A's, one year after the Pirates picked him in the 28th round. Sulser is the seventh Big Green player taken in the top 10 rounds during Whalen's tenure and 14th since the inception of the draft in 1965.

### Not Settling for Spares

Well, this isn't bowling, but if there is one thing the Big Green pitching staff does, it is throw strikes. For the past nine years, the staff has been one of

the stingiest in the country in terms of issuing free passes. In both 2009 and 2010, the Big Green hurlers walked fewer batters per nine innings than any other Division I team. In each of the next three years, they ranked among the top 15, placing third in 2011 at 2.24 behind only Florida (1.82) and Dayton (2.18), eighth in 2012 at 2.33, and 13th in 2013 at 2.52. After two years in the top 50 at fewer than three per game, the Big Green were back near the top in 2016 (11th, 2.66) and again last year (ninth, 2.63), plus rank th so far in 2018 (2.92).

### Big League Bloodlines

Over the past decade-plus, Dartmouth has had five players that had a father with big league ties. First was first baseman Mike Pagliarulo '09 whose father of the same name manned the hot corner with the Yankees, Padres, Twins, Orioles and Rangers over 11 seasons (1984-93, '95), hitting 134 homers in his career. Then came catcher Chris O'Dowd '13, son of Dan O'Dowd who served as the general manager for the Colorado Rockies for 15 years through 2014. Next up was Adam Charnin-Aker, whose father Jack Aker pitched as a reliever in the big leagues for 11 years (1964-74) with the Kansas City (then Oakland) Athletics, Seattle Pilots, Yankees, Cubs, Braves and Mets, going 47-45 with a 3.28 ERA and 124 saves in 495 appearances.

The current team has two such players. Sophomore **Trevor Johnson** is the son of former Big Green first baseman/pitcher/quarterback Mark Johnson '90, who enjoyed a seven-year stay in the bigs with the Pittsburgh Pirates, Anaheim Angels and New York Mets (1995-2002), hitting .232 with 38 homers. This year, **Bennett McCaskill** joined the roster after playing at Torrey Pines for his father, Kirk, who pitched for 12 seasons in the majors, winning 106 games while posting a 4.12 ERA for the California Angels and Chicago White Sox (1985-96).

### MLB Watch

In the summer of 2014, Kyle Hendricks '12 made his MLB debut with the Chicago Cubs and finished his rookie year with a 7-2 record over 13 starts with a 2.46 ERA. Three years later he is an established big leaguer who led both leagues with an ERA of 2.13 in 2016, finishing third in the Cy Young balloting and helping the Cubs win their first World Series in 108 years. In four seasons in Chicago, Hendricks boasts a 38-22 record with an ERA of 2.94 and more strikeouts (507) than hits allowed.
